Click on **Level Search**. The Leveled Reader Database Level Search page will appear.



1. Choose a Level

Assign to the Class

Click on the Title of the book or the cover on the Search Results- Details page

- Click on *assign to class/group*
- Place a check mark beside the class you want to assign the leveled reader
- Next, choose the time frame you want the reader to be available to your class
- Click *Next*

Assign to Students

Click on the Title of the book or the cover

- Choose the time frame you would like the leveled reader to be available to your students
- Click on the Class Name to choose the students
- Then, choose the students you want to assign the leveled reader
- Click *Confirm*

Student View

When students log in to their Pearson SuccessNet account, they will see links to their Leveled Readers at the bottom of their home page. Students simply click on the title to see the leveled reader.
