



Orientation to the Premium Digital System

Introduction This guide discusses the Texas enVisionMATH Premium Digital System. It explains how to log in to Pearson SuccessNet and discusses the organization of the Teacher Center. This guide also describes the features of the Premium Digital System.

Log In To begin, go to PearsonSuccessNet.com. Log in to the account by typing a user name and password and then clicking **Log In**. Register for an account if a username and password is needed.

Teacher Center Organization After logging in, the Teacher Center Home page appears.



My Teacher Resources appears on the left. This is where the enVisionMATH program can be found.

In the center of the page is My Classes and Groups. On the righthand side of the page are the Additional Resources and Messages.

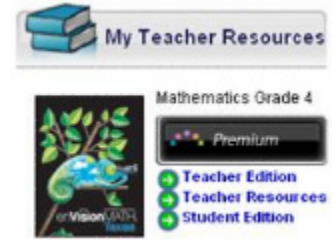
The main features are organized within the tabs along the top of the page. The Content tab holds the enVisionMATH Table of Contents, Tests, and Search. The Planning tab houses Lesson Planner, Assignments, and My Tests, which is where teachers can build custom tests.

On the Classes tab, create and manage classes. On the Reports tab, view lesson progress and test results for the lessons and tests students complete online.

The Texas enVisionMATH Premium Digital System provides access to the Teacher's and Student Editions, Lesson Planner, assignments, tests, and reports. There is also a link to additional Teacher Resources. Most important is the black Premium button, which provides access to the interactive lesson content.



The interactive lesson content includes the Visual Learning Animations, Topic Opener Videos and Interactive Math Stories, interactive Guided Practice, and Lesson Quizzes. Students can access this content from their Student Center.
