

Speak and Record Activities

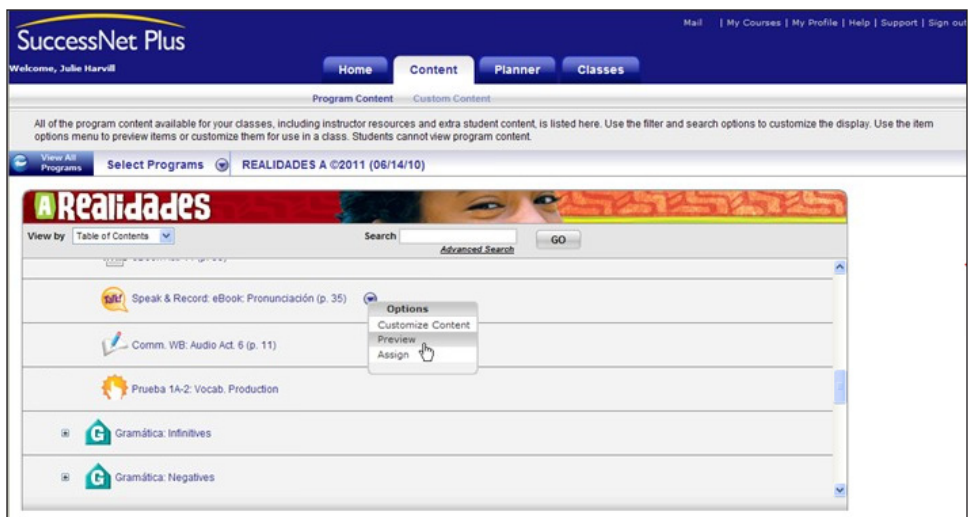
This guide explains how to complete Speak and Record activities on Realidades.com.

To find the Speak and Record activities, log into my Realidades.com teacher account on SuccessNet Plus and click the Content tab. The Speak and Record activities appear on the Table of Contents with the Talk! icon.

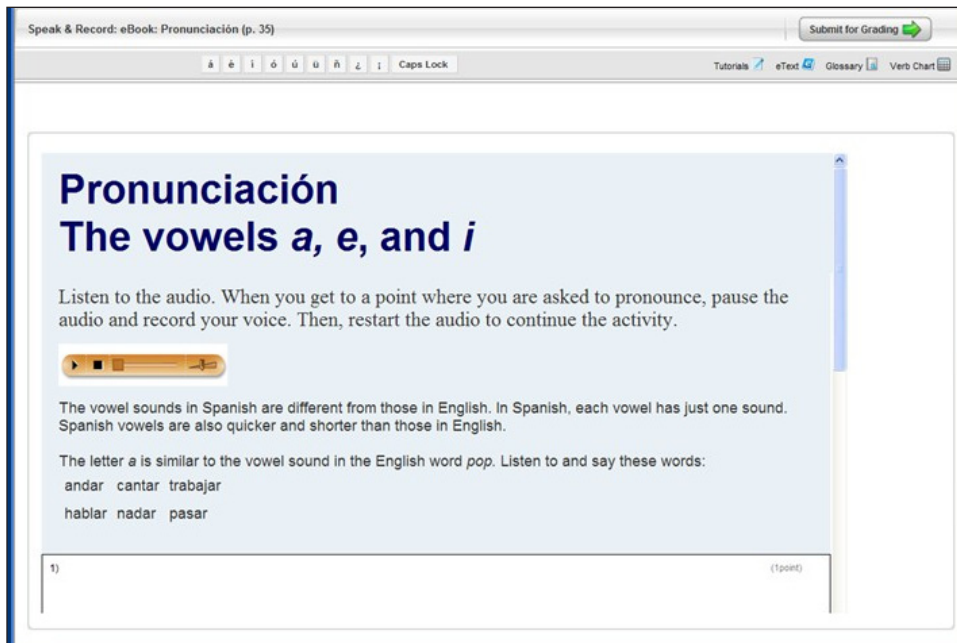


Students see these activities on their To Do list when they log in to their student account. These activities allow students to practice pronunciation and other speaking activities and submit them for grading.

To launch a Speak and Record activity, click the title or select **Preview** from the Options menu.

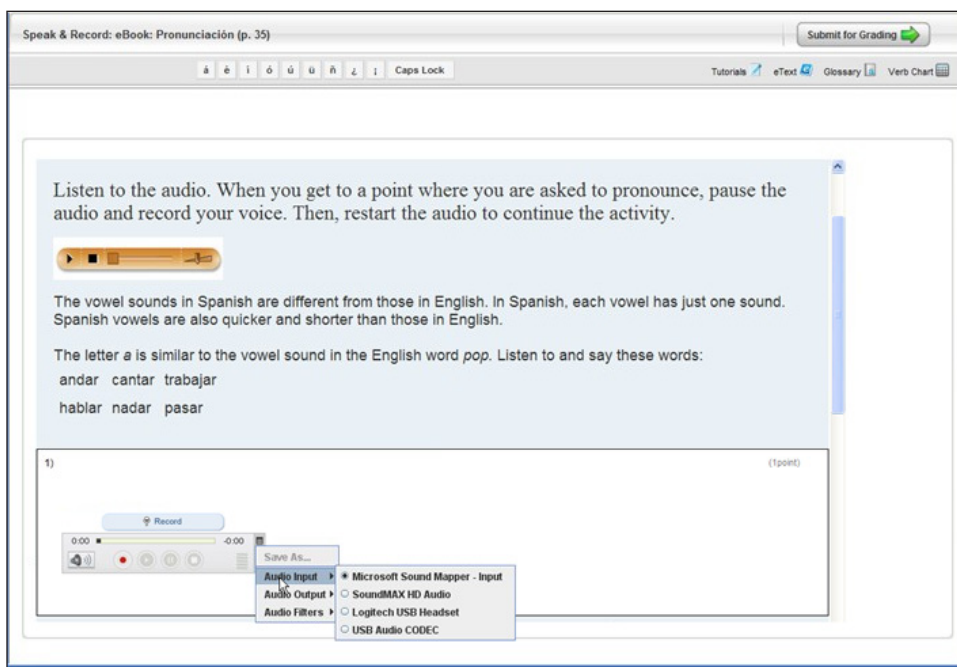


The activity window appears. Use a microphone to complete these activities. In a pronunciation activity, the student has the opportunity to both listen to and speak a list of vocabulary words to practice specific vowel sounds.



After practicing the words and vowel sounds, students record these words. Students click the Record button for the first speaking exercise.

The recorder now appears. To check if the correct recording and playback devices are selected, click the top right corner of the recorder. Select the correct input device.



To begin recording, click record and start speaking. Click **Stop** when recording is finished. The recording is automatically saved. Click **Play** to listen to it.

To replace an unsatisfactory recording, repeat the recording process. A message appears to override the current recording. Click **Yes** and then begin speaking. This replaces the previous recording.

Students continue until they complete each exercise. After they finish, they click **Submit for Grading**. The activity awaits a teacher's review in the Gradebook.
