

Teachers: Learner Settings

Introduction This guide explains learner settings on SuccessNet Plus.

Pearson products on SuccessNet Plus help teachers personalize and deliver assessment-based instruction.

Leveled Content Some Pearson products offer leveled content. The learner setting determines which level of content each student receives. The system checks the learner setting at the time a student opens an activity and delivers that level of content. The leveled content is not set when an assignment is made but rather when the student opens the assignment.

Modify Learner Settings Learner-leveling activities automatically modify learner settings, and learner settings can be managed manually as well. Teachers can change a student's learner setting at any time.

From the Table of Contents, activities and assessments with a double-L icon indicates that the activity can modify learner settings.



If a student's learner setting is locked, learner-leveling activities will not modify the learner setting.

Examples of learner-leveling activities include pre-tests, readiness assessments, topic or unit tests, and progress monitoring activities. Just look for the double-L icon.

Manage Learner Settings

To manage learner settings for products that offer leveled content:

1. Log in to SuccessNet Plus and click **Student Performance**.
2. On the Gradebook tab, click **Learner Settings**. For most products, the default learner setting is on-level.
3. Click the **Edit** link to display the levels used by the product.
4. Change the learner setting.

5. Click **Done**.
6. Click **Save**.

A name now appears in the Modified By column since the learner setting was manually changed. Two dashes mean that the learner setting remains unchanged from the default level.

When a learner setting is locked, it cannot be modified. To take advantage of the automatic learner-leveling feature, leave the learner setting unlocked.

Lock a Learner Setting

1. Click **Edit**.
2. Click the lock.

3. Click **Done**.
4. Save your changes.

Unlock a Learner Setting

When a learner setting is locked, follow these steps to unlock the learner setting:

1. Click **Edit**.
2. Click the lock.
