

## Teachers: Report Types

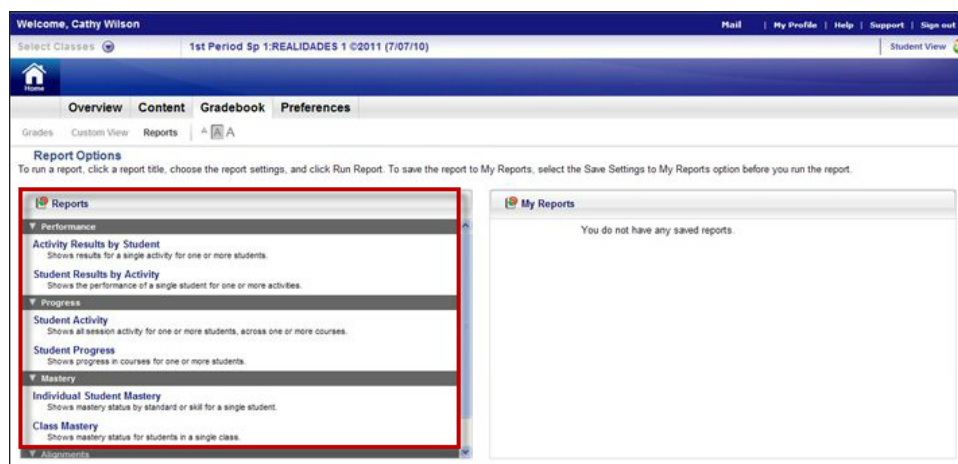
**Introduction** This guide talks about reports on SuccessNet Plus.

### Accessing Reports

To access the reports, follow these steps:

1. Log in to SuccessNet Plus.
2. Select a class.
3. Click **Student Performance** on the Products and Classes channel.
4. On the Gradebook tab, click **Reports**.

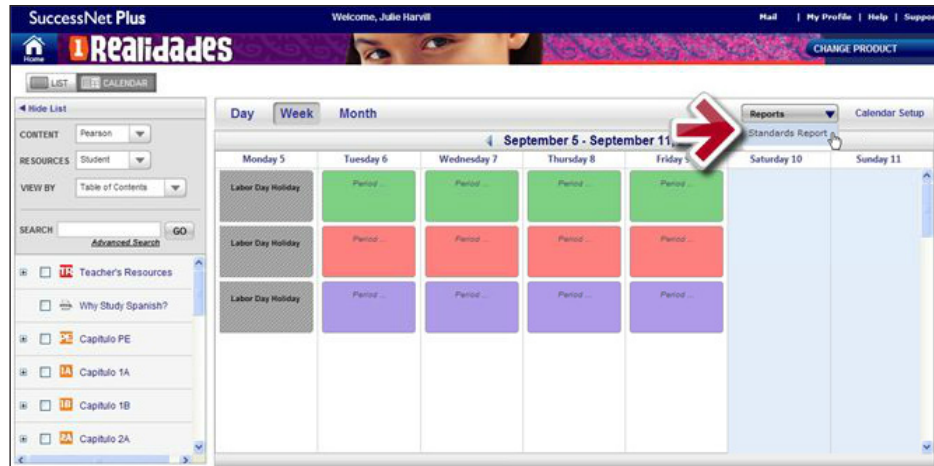
The report categories, such as Performance, Progress, and Mastery, are on the left. Keep in mind that products may offer different reports.



**Common Report Types** Here are some of the most common report types:

- The Activity Results by Student report shows how one or more students performed on a single activity. This report is available for all activities.
- The Student Results by Activity report provides performance results for an individual student.
- The Study Plan Results report shows how students are progressing on each study plan activity. Not all products use study plans.
- The Mastery reports show mastery for one or more skills or standards. Run this report for an individual student or for one or more students in the class.

- Standards Covered by Lesson Plans shows a list of standards covered based on the scheduled lesson plans for a selected date range. This report can also be run from the calendar by clicking **Reports** and selecting **Standards Report**.



- Run the Assignment Details report from the Grades tab. Click **Grades**. Click the Options menu for an assignment, and then select **View Details**. This report is an item analysis report that displays which questions most students missed. This information is helpful to make informed decisions about reteaching specific skills and concepts.
- The reports in the Progress category provide information about how much time students spend online and the percentage of course content they have completed.
