In this guide, we will look at how to access the California Teacher Center Online using Pearson SuccessNet. The Teacher Center is a suite of teaching tools that help you plan lessons, make presentations to your class, and assess your student’s understanding.

To remember what the Teacher Center is all about, remember 3 things:

- Planning
- Presentation
- Assessment

Pearson SuccessNet

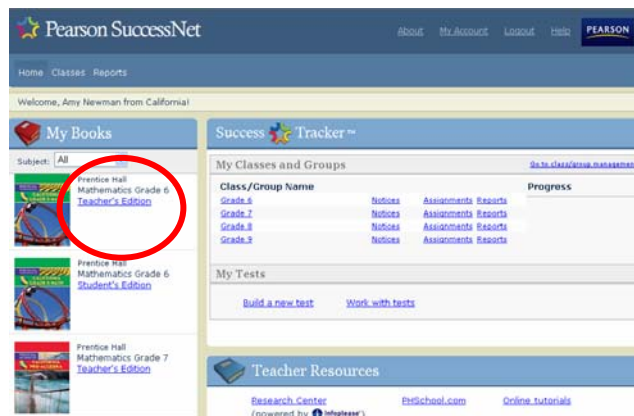
The Teacher Center Online is accessed by logging into your Pearson SuccessNet teacher account. If you have never logged in, you will want to **watch the Pearson SuccessNet tutorials** available on this web site. These will guide you through the process of setting up your account. Log In

To access your **Teacher Center Online**:

1. Go to www.pearsonsuccessnet.com and enter your username and password
2. Click on **Log in**
3. You will be welcomed to the teacher homepage
4. Click on the **Teacher’s Edition** link

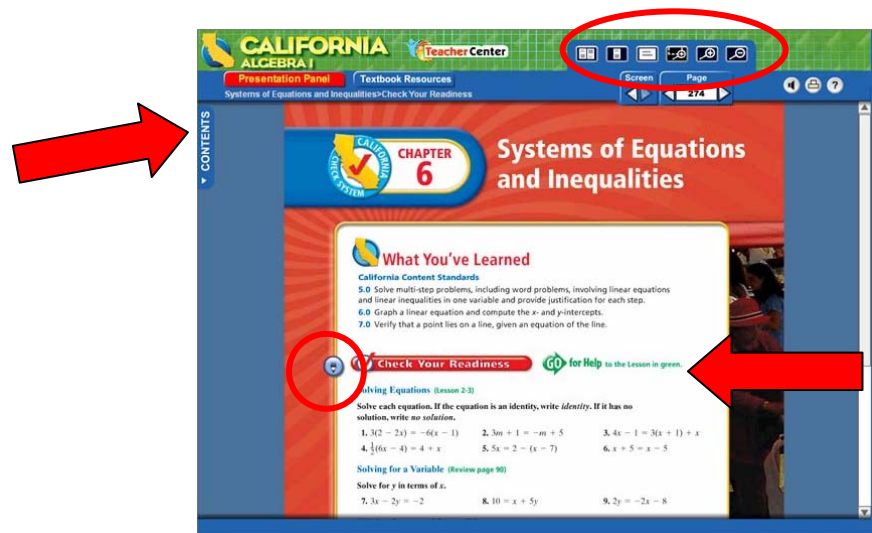


5. A window appears, click on “**To launch the iText: Click here.**”
6. Find your Teacher’s Edition and links to Textbook Resources and Presentation Panel

Textbook Resources

Notice the **Textbook Resources** tab and your complete Teacher's Edition. To find resources within your Teacher's Edition:

- Click on the **Contents** tab and choose Chapter 6 (our sample chapter)



By choosing the different icons at the top right, you can see the entire page, zoom in and out, or view pages side by side.

To launch a quiz, click on the **pencil tab**. To launch a glossary, click on a **vocabulary word**. Have it read aloud to you by pressing the audio icon.

The **“Go for Help”** references provide a page reference where students can go to get additional practice with problems that cover that skill.

The **California Standards Check's** at the bottom of each page serve as a great way to check students' understanding of California state objectives.

Presentation Panel

The **Presentation Panel** lists all of the interactivities you can click on within your Teacher's Edition. Click on the red tab to the **Presentation Panel**. It's broken into 3 resource sections:

1. Launch
2. Teach
3. Assess



If you hover your mouse over a particular type of resource, you can see the format.

Let's check out some of the resources in the **Presentation Panel**:

Under **Launch**, you'll find:

- Check Skills You'll Need

Under **Teach**, you have links to:

- Chapter Vocabulary
 - Launches Electronic Flashcards
- Lesson Key Concepts
- Step-by-Step Examples
- The California Standards Check

Under **Assess**, you have links to:

- Lesson Quiz
- Answers to Exercises

If you drop-down the **grey button** and you'll find even more resources in the form of **Activities and Videos** to use within your classroom!
