To remember what the Teacher Center is all about, remember 3 things:

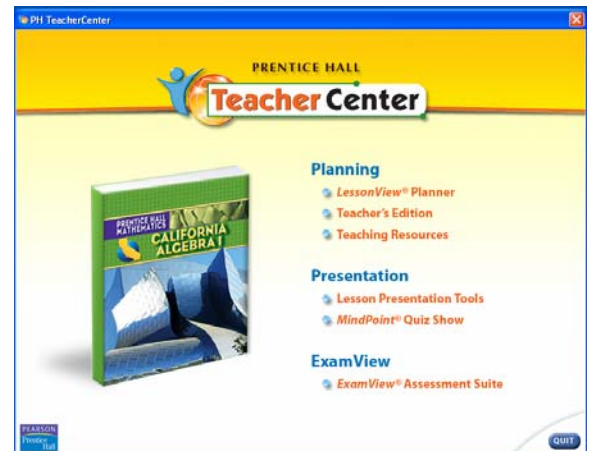
- Planning

The California Teacher Center comes in two different flavors:
CD-ROM and Online

Teacher Center on CD-ROM

To launch your California Teacher Center on CD-ROM:

1. Double-click the Teacher Center icon on your desktop
2. Find resources for:
 - Planning
 - Presentation
 - ExamView



Planning

Under **Planning**, you have access to:

- LessonView Planner
- Teacher's Edition
- Teaching Resources

If you click on the link to **LessonView Planner**, it opens a powerful lesson planning tool that includes your Teacher's Edition, and the Teaching Resources you'll need to plan your daily lessons. You can also launch the Teacher's Edition and other Teaching Resources.

Presentation

Under **Presentation**, you have access to:

- Lesson Presentation Tools
- MindPoint Quiz Show

To access your **Lesson Presentation Tools**:

1. Click **Lesson Presentation Tools**
2. Choose your **chapter**
3. You are taken to your Teacher's Edition where you'll find:
 - **Textbook Resources**
 - Find your entire Teacher's Edition
 - If you click on vocabulary it launches a glossary
 - **Presentation Panel**
 - Find all the resources you'll want to use in one place

To access your **ExamView** resources:

1. Click the link to **ExamView Assessment Suite**
2. The ExamView Test Generator opens
3. Choose to:
 - Create a test using the wizard
 - Create a test from scratch
 - Open existing tests
- Create or Open a new question bank
